SELECTEE REQUIREMENTS

We are asking that you as administrators (Principals & Athletic Directors) take a few minutes to identify one male and one female student-athlete that are exceptional in each of the following three categories: 1) academics 2) athletics 3) involvement within their school and communities. What we are looking for is an impressive balance of all three. These are student-athletes that excel academically, athletically, and within their schools and communities. Possibly, the most important of all characteristics, is the rare trait of humility. Current juniors are eligible to attend. If there is a sophomore that you feel really good about, they also qualify. We understand that this caliber of an individual is uncommon and hard to find; however, we know that they exist, and it is our mission to work with administrators to identify and select such people.

DETAILS

Student-athletes need to report to the main office at Maple Mountain High School for check-ins by no later than 10:00am on Friday, March 10, 2017, and then picked up at 7:00pm on Saturday, March 11, 2017. Transportation can be performed by the school, parents, or selectees. All meals and camp materials will be provided by Camp U Leadership. On Friday night, student-athletes will be staying the night at the high school under camp supervision.

COMPLETED REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS NEED TO BE MAILED IN BY NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 10, 2017 (See registration instructions below). As soon as we have received your registrations, we will send a confirmation email to each school administrator, student-athlete, and parent/guardian, which will contain a list of materials to bring, camp itinerary, and all other relevant information. Expect the email by Monday, February 27, 2017.

Obviously, such an event requires funding. It is up to the school to cover the nominal fee of \$50/student-athlete (\$100/school). If the school declines, that fee can be paid by the selectees. These sacred funds are exclusively used to provide the following: food, camp materials, team-building activities, spirit packs (Camp U branded apparel), keynote speaker, scholarships, prizes, and all other resources used to enhance Camp U Leadership.

After you have selected your two student-athletes, complete the following:

- 2. **Confirm Registrations**: When selectees have completed and returned their profile and waiver to a school administrator, <u>send</u> the following in by no later than **Friday**, **February 10**, **2017**:
 - a. Student-Athlete Profile & Photo ID (both selectees)
 - b. Waiver & Release Form (both selectees)
 - c. Check (\$50/selectee = \$100 Total)

CAMP OVERVIEW
